ATTUNE aims to support schools and settings in Wolverhampton to develop and enhance their whole-school approach to trauma informed & attachment aware practice, to promote well being and anti-bullying practice.

What does the ATTUNE Project include?

- EP support and guidance over a two year period to support your journey
- Support to evaluate your current practice, strengths and areas for development.
- Collection and analysis of key information and data through an audit, staff surveys, parent and pupil focus groups and school 'trauma informed walk throughs'.
- 1.5 days whole school trauma, attachment and emotion coaching training delivered by the Wolverhampton EPS.
- Facilitation of a bespoke Development Plan for your school, reviewed together at termly intervals and certificates provided for bronze, silver and gold schools.
- The project is subsidised by the Wolverhampton Virtual School and Public Health. Cost to schools will be £500 per year, over a 2 year period.
