### Harmful Sexual Behaviour Brook Traffic Light Tool FREE Training for all partners

Wolverhampton Safeguarding Together have commissioned the Brook Traffic Light Tool training to ensure a consistent approach to the identification of, and support provided to, children and young people who present with behaviours that could be sexually harmful.

Now available **online until 31st March 2025**. The training takes **approximately 60-90 minutes** to complete.
